WHAT IS DATA BREACH?

- Actual release or disclosure of information to an unauthorized individual or entity that relates to a person and that may cause the person inconvenience or harm (financial / reputational)

ANY BUSINESS COLLECTING PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION (PII) HAS A RISK.

- PII could be social security number, drivers license number, health records, bank account information, or any information used to identify a person

A BREACH IS NOT JUST ELECTRONIC FILES.

Examples of types of Security Breaches:

- Paper: un-shredded documents, prescription bottles, x-ray images, financial information
- Lost or Stolen Portable Devices: computers, lap tops, smart phones, backup tapes, hard drives, servers, copiers, scanners, printers, flash drives
- Phishing Attacks, hacks, malware viruses
- Rogue or disgruntled employees
